"Conflict Minerals" Statement

(DODD-FRANK WALL STREET REFORM AND CONSUMER PROTECTION ACT—SEC. 1502. CONFLICT MINERALS.)

Dear valued customer,

SEH Computertechnik GmbH is aware of its responsibility regarding (ecological and social) sustainability and assumes its moral responsibility by committing to the peaceful and sustainable use of worldwide resources.

The following information is to assist you in exercising due diligence regarding social and ecological standards as well as in using resources peacefully and sustainably.

According to SEC. 1502. CONFLICT MINERALS. of the

DODD-FRANK WALL STREET REFORM AND CONSUMER PROTECTION ACT
Public Law 111-203
111th Congress

(commonly referred to as "Dodd-Frank Act"), companies which are listed on stock exchanges of the United States of America and which are subject to the supervision agency "U.S. Securities and Exchange Commission" (SEC) have to report the use of conflict minerals in their products. These conflict minerals are mined in the Democratic Republic of the Congo or its neighboring states. Revenues earned from conflict mineral sales are used to finance armed conflict, contribute to severe violations of human rights and further the humanitarian crises in the entire region.

SEH Computertechnik GmbH is not obligated to report according to the Dodd-Frank Act as it is not subject to the SEC supervision.

Nevertheless, as manufacturer SEH Computertechnik GmbH works closely with suppliers and expects them to adhere to ecological and social sustainability principles and to respect human rights. In order to provide transparency and traceability for our products, we have asked our suppliers to provide us with information on whether and to what extent products they deliver to us contain conflict minerals. So far, we do not have any supplier information which states that our products might contain conflict minerals. In addition, we have asked our suppliers to inform us about any changes regarding the use of conflict minerals. In the event of such changes, we will re-evaluate the co-operation with the respective supplier and seek alternative supply sources.


